If you like the convenience of Apple's iCloud Tabs feature, but you don't want to be locked in to using Safari on your Macs, CloudyTabs is the menu bar utility for you. Everyone has their favorite (or least favorite, depending on how you look at it) beefs with Apple's iCloud service. But one of my biggest frustrations is that many of iCloud's most-convenient features require you to use Apple's apps—those features simply don't work with third-party programs. Take iCloud Tabs, the feature that automatically syncs any open Safari tabs across all your OS X and iOS devices. The key word here is *Safari*—iCloud Tabs doesn't support other browsers.
